Tabor Winery: Tabor winery is situated in the heart of the fertile Galilee. Tabor vineyards and winery lay in the foothills of Mt. Tabor. This unique location provides an ideal climate for growing grapes, as well as different soil types.

These factors, and a highly skilled and dedicated team, help to make tabor wines special; wines that exhibit the natural grape aromas and flavors. A bottle of Tabor will always enhance your gatherings and special moments.

Tulip Winery: In 2003 the Itzhaki
Family opened Tulip Winery in Kfar Tikva
(Village of Hope), a village for
adults with developmental and
emotional disabilities.
The combination of the village's
vision and the family's desire to
make wine, resulted in an
exciting wine industry model
that employs members of the
village and provides them with a
business platform that integrates
them in the labor force.

Teperberg Winery was founded by Avraham Teperberg in 1870 in the Old City of Jerusalem. The soils and climate conditions typical of the Judean region provide the grapes with great potential to express their rich and unique flavors. The various regions, soil types, and microclimates further enable the winery to grow each variety in its most suitable terroir. The grapes' qualities are further enhanced by implementing technologies adapted per site, including trellising, drip irrigation, state of the art trimming and pruning systems, in addition to traditional vineyard cultural practices.

Flam Winery: Surrounded by vineyards, the winery is located at the heart of the picturesque Judean Hills around Jerusalem and operates in the classic European Family Estate model. Our vineyards are planted in the Upper Galilee and the Judean Hills, in the best parcels for growing wine grapes. In all our parcels we insist of a very low yield-acre ratio. The variety of soils of our private vineyard, which Golan oversees personally, contributes to the creation of fierce and intense wines that reflect the renewed tradition of Mediterranean winemaking.
